This agenda item was readded back to the agenda at the request of Vice Mayor Hendrix.

After review with Chairman Perez, there will be no legal ramification to the City and at no expense to the City, the recommendation is to authorize the County to proceed with installation of speed bumps.

Chairman Ryan Perez spoke with Vice Mayor Melissa Hendrix on the issues with excessive speeding on NE 8th Avenue, and the possibility of installing speed bumps along NE 8th Avenue that would be at ZERO cost to the City, but because it is a city-owned road, the County needs official authorization to complete this project.

If the board authorizes the County to proceed with this project, the Interim City Clerk can draft up an authorization letter that can be signed by the Mayor and Interim City Clerk and emailed to the Chairman promptly.

For neighborhood safety, and at no expense to the City, the idea to install speed bumps on NE 8th Avenue is sought.

At the commission meeting held on June 20, 2023, the Board approved the job description and salary that former Interim Manager Tillis had drafted, which had a salary range of \$50,000-61,000.

Mathew Kelley (the board selected internal applicant) requested the salary of \$53,000.

At the regular meeting held on September 19, 2023, the Board made the motion to appoint Mathew Kelley as Public Works Director, with a salary of \$45,000, which was a mistake and confusion with the salary of the then vacant public works director position and the vacant finance director position.

In order to correct this error, the suggestion is to adjust the salary of the public works director from \$45,000 to \$53,000 which is what was requested by Mathew Kelley, and is within the salary range initially approved the board on June 20, 2023.
