A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MILLAGE RATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

WHEREAS, The City Commission of the City of Lake Butler is and has held a public hearing on the millage rates for the next fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission approves the millage rate of 3.25 mills for the fiscal year 2024-2025, with no rollback rate; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lake Butler is following the guidelines set forth by the State of Florida Department of Revenue and has been requested to re-approve this; so

NOW THEREFORE, the City of Lake Butler and after publishing a notice for a public hearing in a regional newspaper, holding the public hearing September 17, 2024, at 5:30 PM and evaluating the public input now approves the 3.25 mills to be effective as of October 1, 2024 and run through September 30, 2025; and

HEREBY, a motion to re-approve the millage rate per the Department of Revenue with the motion being made by Commissioner <u>August</u> will levy a

millage rate of 3.25 mills with no rollback rate on all property within the city limits for the fiscal year period covering October 1, 2023 through September 30, 2024.
